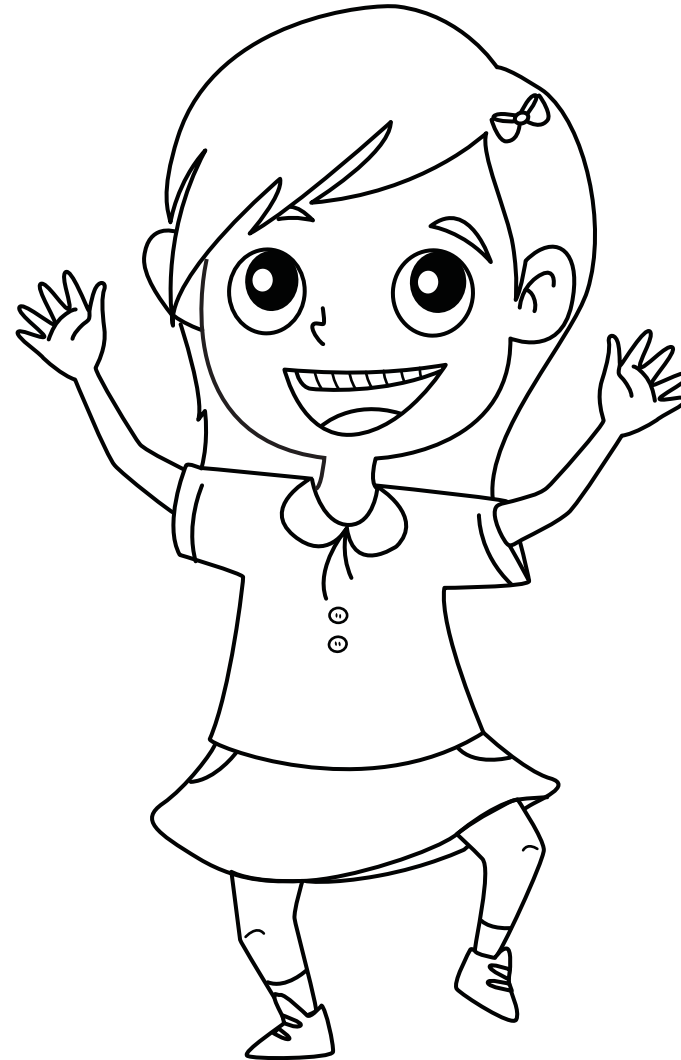
knees = blue

Part 1: Encourage students to write over the words using the indicated colors.

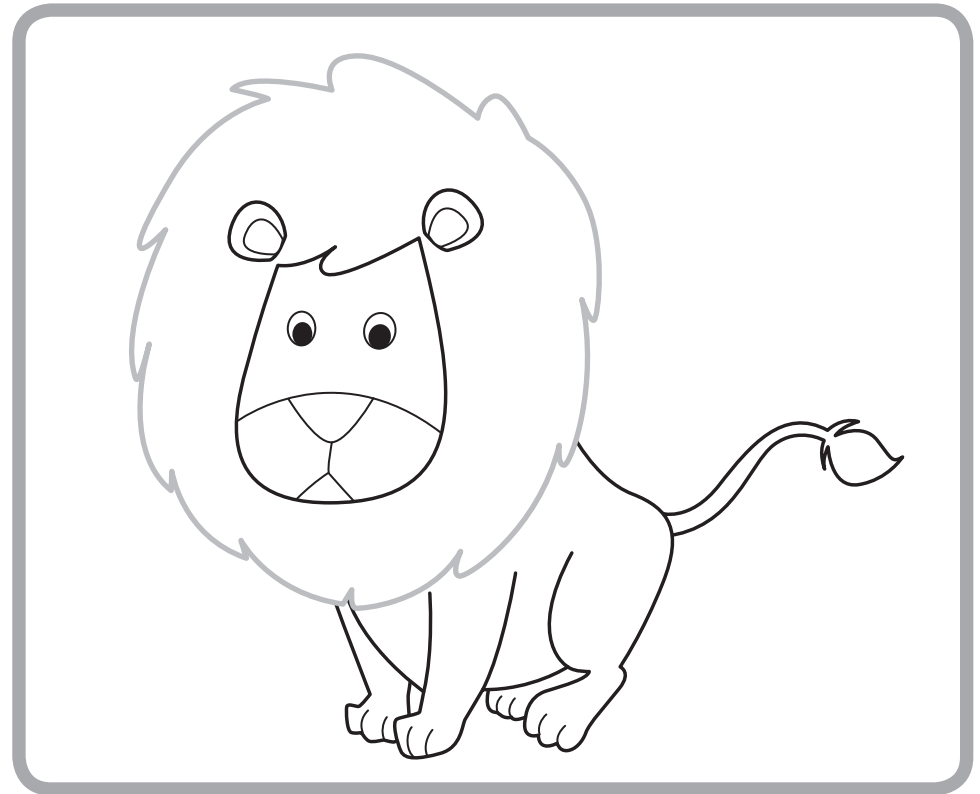
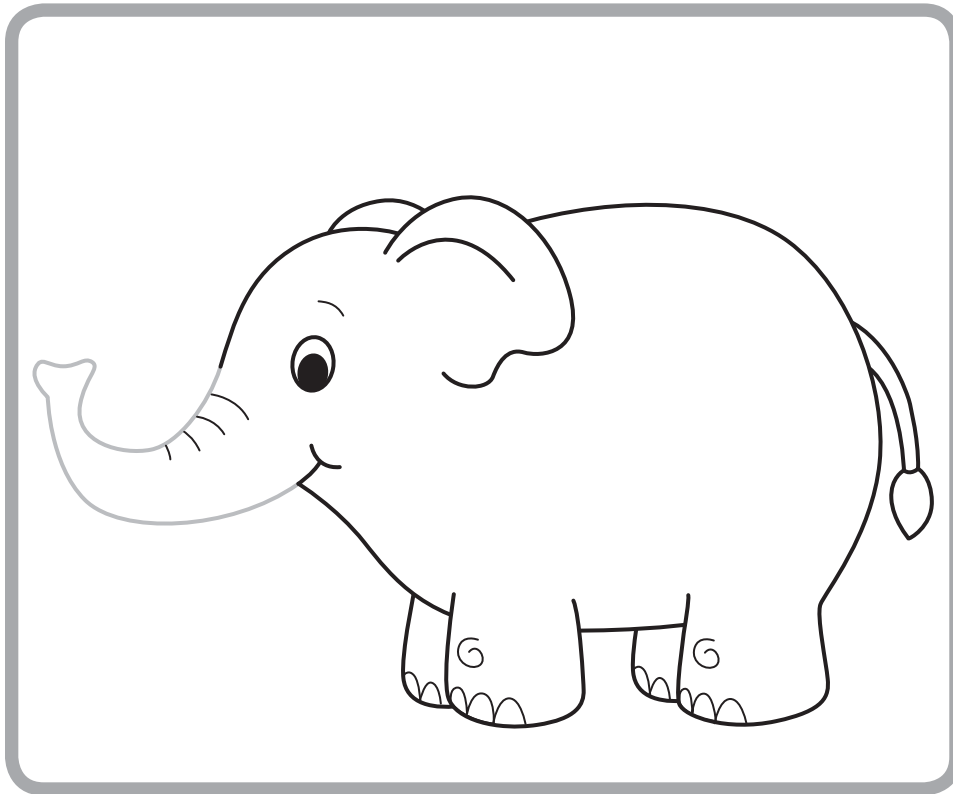
Part 2: Have them color the body parts using the color code.

Materials: pencil, crayons

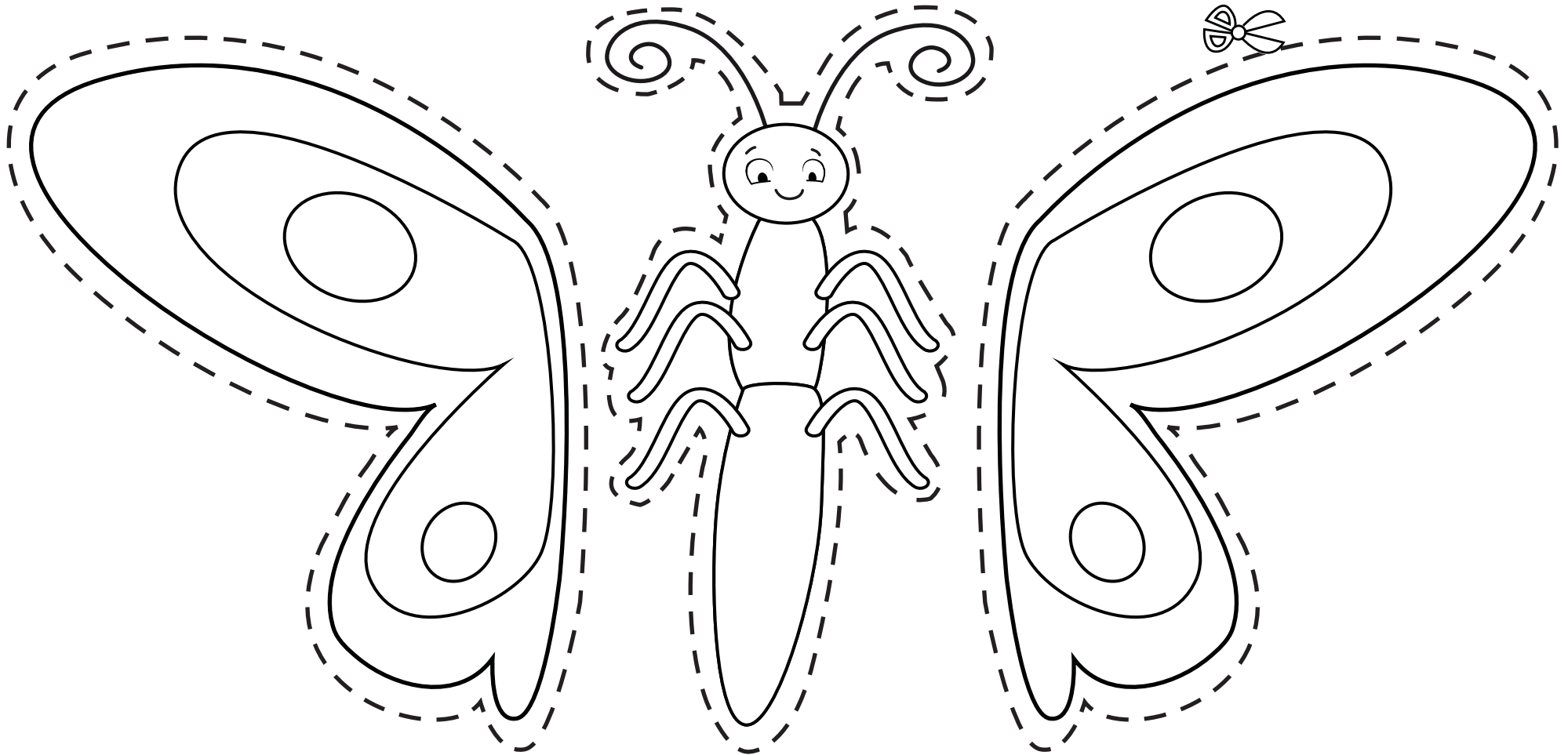
Instructions:

Instructions:

Part 1: Encourage students to color and cut out the wings and the body of the butterfly.

Part 2: Have them paste the wings onto the butterfly and paste the butterfly onto a tongue depressor to make a stick puppet.

Part 3: Have students form pairs and say the parts of the insect that they remember: *It has wings. It has 6 legs. It has an antennae.*
