



## Easter Chick and Bunny

**Materials (per student):** 2 ice cream cups, paint (yellow and white), 1 paintbrush, colored pencils, scissors, glue, small candies or chocolates

**Instructions:** Print out and photocopy the Easter Chick and Bunny template (1 per student). Teach students *chick* and review *bunny* with them. Point to the picture of the finished products. Explain to students that they are going to make chick and bunny candy cups for Easter. Say *chick* and *bunny* and encourage students to repeat. Next, distribute ice cream cups, paint, paintbrushes, colored pencils, scissors and glue. Tell students to paint one ice cream cup yellow and the other white. Allow them to dry. Distribute templates. Have students identify and color the bunny's ears, face and feet. Then, have them identify and color the chick's face, wings, tail and feet. Have students cut out all the body parts and help them glue them onto the cups. Distribute the candies or chocolates and have students fill each cup with them. Encourage students to take their candy cups home for Easter to share with their families.
