



Father's Day Trophy

Materials (per student): 2 disposable cups, glue, scissors, construction paper, 1 paintbrush, gold paint, colored pencils

Instructions: Print out and photocopy the Father's Day Trophy template (1 per student). Teach students the word *trophy*. Point to the picture of the finished product. Explain to students that they are going to make a trophy for their father. Say *trophy* and encourage students to repeat. Next, distribute materials. Tell students to glue the disposable cups together to form a trophy. Distribute templates. Have students cut out the trophy handle shapes, paste them onto construction paper and cut them out again. Then, have students paint the cups and handles with gold paint. Allow them to dry and tell students to glue the handles to the sides of the first cup (see the picture of the finished product). Point to the text and help students read it: *Number 1 Dad*. Tell students to color the stars and text and cut them out. Finally, have them glue them to the trophy. Encourage students to give their trophies to their fathers as a Father's Day present.
